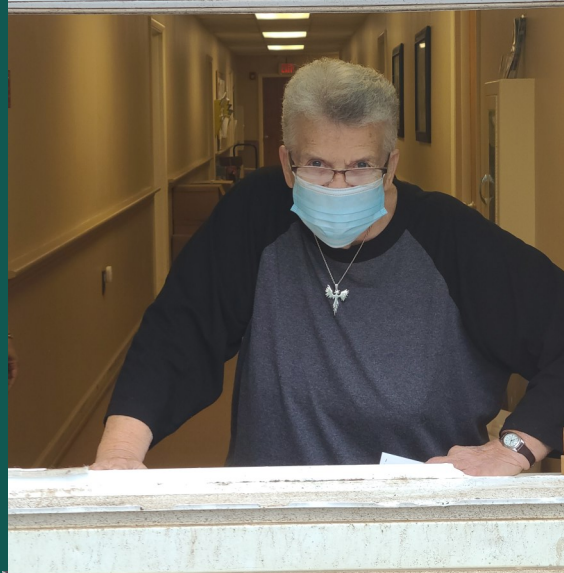
2020 Report and Appeal for Financial and Volunteer Support

2020 — what a year. Despite COVID 19, economic concerns, racial tensions and a difficult presidential election, 2020 has been an extraordinary, heartfelt, and visionary year at Hope's Table. Our many volunteers continue to be the energy and lifeblood of our work together. Here are some of our 2020 developments during a challenging, adaptive year!

- 80 patrons (each with families) receive 4-5 bags of culturally appropriate groceries on Wednesdays — whenever they need it.
- ESL classes meet online.
- Organizational Leadership team incorporating leadership from Spanish speaking community.
- New classroom space expands Hope's Table possibilities.
- Denominational leadership helps us apply for an Ameri-Corps volunteer for the Spring of 2021.
- "Amigos de Wharton" establishes: a group of Spanish speakers working together to improve the lives of parents and children in Wharton..
- \$34,500.00 raised through grants from denominational, federal and state grant sources.
- \$10,000 raised from individuals in the community.



We have been recognized as a community asset. As we grow, we become more connected and caring for one another. And we reach out to even more persons — all inspired to the work of building diverse, inclusive and generous community.

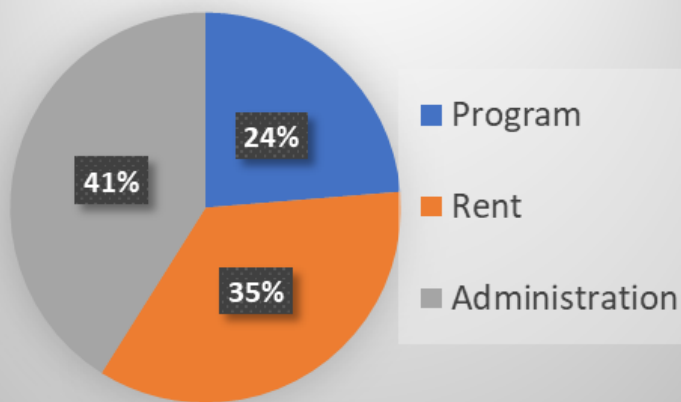

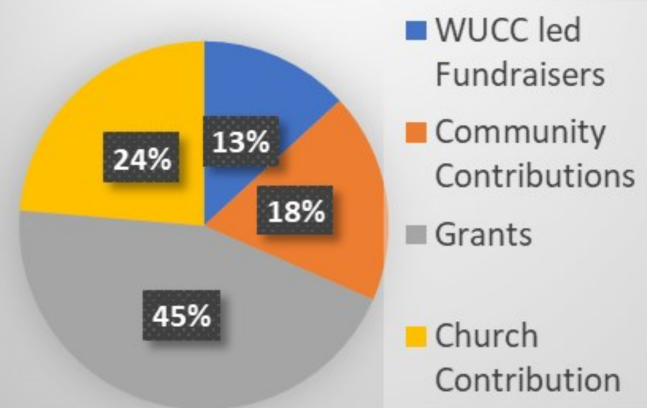
